Ladd motioned seconded by Christensen to approve the agenda with a slight change to item number 12 – Distributed Generation Facility rather than Distributed General Facility. Ayes: Christensen and Ladd; motion carried.

Christensen motioned seconded by Ladd to approve the minutes from the October 11th meeting. Ayes: Christensen and Ladd; motion carried.

Ayes: Christensen and Ladd; motion carried.

Chairperson Schneider entered the meeting at 8:20 AM.

Tonderum reviewed 2022 insurance renewal amounts for health (12% increase), dental (2% increase) and vision (no increase) insurance. Motion by Christensen seconded by Ladd to renew all three plans with the same benefit as 2021. Ayes: Christensen, Ladd and Schneider; motion carried.

Foster presented the Board with the 2022 wage and benefit request from non-management employees. Motion by Christensen seconded by Ladd for a 4.5% wage increase for all non-management employees along with leaving insurance at GMU paying 100% of the employee coverage and 90% of family coverage and a \$500 contribution per employee to the Flex Spending Account. Ayes: Christensen, Ladd and Schneider; motion carried.

Motion by Christensen seconded by Ladd to match the management employees 2022 wage increase and benefits to the non-management employees at 4.5% wage increase along with leaving insurance at GMU paying 100% of the employee coverage and 90% of family coverage and a \$500 contribution per employee to the Flex Spending Account. Ayes: Christensen, Ladd and Schneider; motion carried.

Tonderum presented draft copies of GMU Distributed Generation Interconnection Standards and GMU Agreement for Electrical Service and Interconnection of Distributed Generation Facility to the Board for review. These documents are the first step in GMU customers being able to have solar options on their property. Approval was tabled for the December meeting to allow everyone a chance to review and absorb the information.

Motion by Christensen seconded by Ladd to approve Resolution #3.21 – Avoided Cost Rate for Distributed Generation. This resolution sets the rate at \$0.02612/kWh for June 1, 2021 through May 31, 2022. Ayes: Christensen, Ladd and Schneider; motion carried.

Mayor Schultz reported that the City will resume work on a solar ordinance in conjunction with GMU's Distributed Generation policies.

MANAGEMENT REPORT:

Board members received preliminary copies of the FY21 audit reports to review before the December meeting. Lake levels were reviewed. Tonderum reported that City of Fontanelle has voted to contract the operation and maintenance of their electric and water utilities to GMU for a 3 year period beginning January 1, 2022. Agreements will be drawn up for signature prior to the end of the year. The electric project near Cardinal IG is on track for completion by the end of the year.
