Tonderum reviewed the Don Carlos Insurance Renewal – April 2025 to March 2026. The annual cost will be \$147,371.92 which is an increase of 16.8%. Motion by Christensen seconded by Cooper to approve the insurance renewal. Ayes: Christensen, Cooper and Ladd; motion carried.

Motion by Christensen seconded by Cooper to approve the Annual Electric Reliability Plan for Iowa Utilities Commission. Ayes: Christensen, Cooper and Ladd; motion carried.

Tonderum reviewed the Nodaway Lake Spillway Analysis and Repair Options. HR Green will be creating a bid spec sheet for GMU to send out to local contractors for bids. More information to come at the next meeting.

Motion by Cooper seconded by Christensen to approve the Nodaway Lake Spillway Geophysical Exploration Proposal from Terracon for \$4,000. Ayes: Christensen, Cooper and Ladd; motion carried.

Motion by Christensen seconded by Cooper to approve a 1 year maintenance agreement with IXOM (SolarBee) for 1 time per year service and water testing in the amount of \$10,300. Ayes: Christensen, Cooper and Ladd; motion carried.

Tonderum and Foster gave an update on the disaster recovery progress and FEMA project status.

There were no formal customer or guest comments.

The meeting was adjourned at 0:21 a m

GMU continues to help Fontanelle, Orient & Massena as needed. Progress on the final design of the Water Treatment Plant is slowly moving forward. GMU will be helping DGR Engineering with designing an underground electrical conversion in Orient. Electric crews will be starting to work on converting the temporary street lights on wooden poles to permanent fiberglass poles in the coming weeks. Tree cleanup at the lake is progressing and the first two piles have been burned. There is a tree grant through Hy-Vee and the Arbor Day Foundation being applied for to get trees at the Lake Greenfield. H K Scholz Company started work on the transformer upgrades at the North Substation this week.
